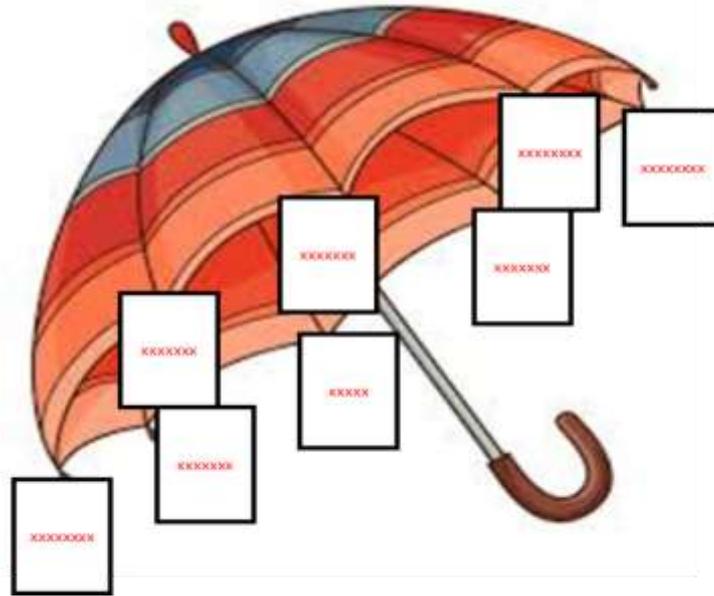
Methods

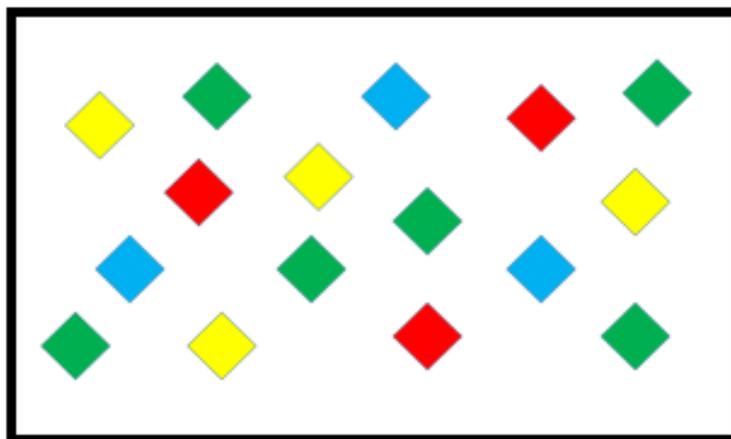
It is commonly considered that every tutor have to know a number of methods in order to organize high-quality training and activities and to establish close contact with students. Let's take a look different methods and techniques which can be utilized in tutoring. One of them is the method called "The secret in the palm".

The "Secret in the palm" - the purpose of this method is to organize the process of acquaintance with students in an interesting and memorable way and to direct students to express their thoughts freely in front of the group on different topics [7]. Necessaries: gloves (medical use), box, drinking water container (plastic), empty container, water, stickers and pen. We collect medical gloves in one box. Pour some water into an empty larger container. We can open the plastic drinking water container by cutting both sides from the top and bottom. Organizing process: Gloves are distributed to everyone. Students write their names/opinions about the topic on a sticker or on the glove itself. After all the writing is done, the gloves are collected and students take turns to choose one of the optional gloves, put it in a bowl of water, show the existing writing and say it aloud to the group. The named student stands up and gives a brief introduction/explains his/her opinion. The training will continue in this form.

The "Umbrella" method - this method is used for organizing tutoring sessions in an interesting way, to strengthen the knowledge given during the session and to determine feedback for training in an interactive way. Necessaries: Umbrella, papers, marker, glue. Method of preparation and use: we write down various questions on 8-10 white papers and glue them around the umbrella. During the training, one member of the students is selected and called to the center and an umbrella is attached to him. The student turns the umbrella and stops it with his eyes closed. Then he opens his eyes, takes a paper with a question about it and gives the answer. The training will continue in this way with other participants.



The “Energy” method - through this method, the student's thinking and creativity skills are developed. It can be added that the tutor has the opportunity to learn a little about the psychology of his student through what he says. Necessaries: sticker papers for questions, pen, A3 hard paper [9]. Method of preparation and use: We write questions about student goals and plans on sticky notes and place them on A3 paper. We put the prepared set of questions on the board. Students who express their desire to participate in the lesson come to the blackboard individually and choose one of the question stickers. They read the question and give their answers. Students get energy from each other's thoughts and pay more attention to the lesson.

In today's rapidly developing era, cooperation with students for higher educational institutions has become one of the fastest and most effective ways to achieve development in the field of education. Therefore, the role and importance of skilled tutors has increased significantly [8]. In every institute and university, tutors started to work with students and help them in every aspect.
